6	Gallery Rebels	Art and Design	Visit a gallery	<p><b>Dorman Museum:</b> Visit to museum and exhibitions, including Christopher Dresser</p> <p><b>Hartlepool Museum:</b> Visit to museum and exhibitions</p> <p><b>MIMA:</b> Visit to museum and exhibitions</p>
6	Frozen Kingdom	Geography	Ice investigations	<p><b>Captain Cook Museum:</b> Use globes and atlases to find and name polar regions. Investigate animals which inhabit these areas. Consider how they are adapted for their environment. Investigate and create indigenous art. Investigate the role of Captain Cook in exploring the Arctic and Antarctic.</p>
6	A Child's War	History	Role play evacuees	<p><b>Dorman Museum:</b> interactive workshop using artefacts, focussing on Middlesbrough during the war.</p> <p><b>Teesside Archives:</b> Role play on evacuation. Use a range of source materials to investigate Middlesbrough in the war. Life on the "home front".</p> <p><b>Cleveland Ironstone Museum:</b> Daily life, rationing, shelter, games, air raid and school</p> <p><b>Museum of Hartlepool:</b> Why Hartlepool was bombed (creative writing opportunity)</p>

				<p><b>MIMA:</b> Using works of art to investigate aspects of WW11</p> <p><b>Teesside Archives:</b> Use role play to imagine what it would like to be evacuated. Use real life objects to make choices about what you would take. Use a range of source materials to investigate what Middlesbrough was like during the war. 6	Darwin’s Delights	Science	Animal specimen observation	<p><b>Kirkleatham outdoor:</b> Use historical sources to find out about Charles Darwin. Look at scientific journals. Collect natural items</p> <p><b>Saltholme:</b> Habitats (compost heap, woodpile, minibeast hotel)</p> <p><b>Life Centre, Newcastle:</b> Animal Adaptation, Darwin’s Worms, Evolution on Clippy Island, Food Chains and Classification</p> <p><b>North York Birds of Prey:</b> Handling a variety of birds of prey and flying demonstration</p>
6	Hola Mexico!	Music	Mexican music performance	<p><b>Tees Valley Music Service:</b> composition and performance</p>

6	Revolution	History	Visit a Victorian classroom	<p><b>Cleveland Ironstone Museum:</b> Experience a Victorian classroom, go down the mine and consider lives of poor children, washday and daily life Mining in the Industrial Revolution, portraits of Victorian times Discover Ironstone Mining and steel operations during WW11</p> <p><b>Museum of Hartlepool:</b> Handling artefacts (rich and poor pupils)</p> <p><b>Kirkleatham Museum:</b> Victorian schoolroom experience; Victorian toys and everyday life (including role play) Development of the railways</p> <p><b>Kirkleatham outdoor:</b> Victorian classroom experience. Use source materials to find out about education in Victorian times. Look at range of household items from Victorian times. Find out about Industrial revolution in the local area.</p> <p><b>MIMA:</b> Using works of art to investigate aspects of the Victorian era</p> <p><b>Dorman Museum:</b> Middlesbrough during Victorian times</p> <p><b>Beamish Museum:</b> Aspects of North East life in 1800's and 1900's including transport, village life, mining, farming</p>
